## ALATSKIVI - RANNAMÕISA, 19 km

Smoked fish and onion pie – the culinary heritage of Lake Peipus

Alatskivi is a great place to try the traditional dishes of Lake Peipus, including the famous onion pie. After Alatskivi, the Forest Trail ascends to a higher ground, which offers beautiful views of Lake Peipus, and then descends to meet the shore of the lake again at Kallaste. In Kallaste, look out for the local fish restaurant and shop, and try smoked vendace (rääbis) as well as zander from Lake Peipus. The last part of this section leads along a road overlooking the lake.

Lake Peipus vendace is sold throughout the year. Onion season starts in July, and onions are sold on streets until late September.



If the water level in Lake Peipus is low (depending on the weather and wind direction), beautiful beaches are revealed opposite the Kallaste village, perfect for walking and enjoying the coastal scenery. You can also walk across Kallaste along the Vöidu street, which hosts several shops and summer cafés. You can take a bus from Kallaste to Ranna. See [www.peatus.ee](http://www.peatus.ee).

## FORESTS

There is a museum working in the castle in Alatskivi, and the old manor granary accommodates a nature centre. The park has a study trail. From Alatskivi towards Kallaste the trail leads through agricultural landscape. There is relatively little forest in this area. Predominant alder or birch forests alternate with spruce forests. Forests are intensively managed.

### 1 Kallaste red sandstone cliff.

Estonia's longest Devonian sandstone outcrop.

### 2 Kallaste look-out tower.

A 12-meter-high wooden observation tower overlooking Lake Peipus.

### 3 Kodavere church.

The church was first mentioned in 1342. In the 15th century there was a wooden church.

### 4 Ranna 1000-year-old oak tree.
