KÄSMU - VIINISTU, 26 km

In the kingdom of the giant rocks of Käsmu Peninsula

The first part of this section passes through the fairytale-like Käsmu Peninsula with its wooded dunes and moss-covered rock fields. From Eru it continues along the Võsu - Kotka road for 2 km, passes through Vihasoo village and further along the road, from where you can see Eru Bay and Käsmu Peninsula. The section features some of the most impressive boulders in Lahemaa national park, the Tammispea and Jaani-Tooma boulders, which resemble huge monoliths. From Viinistu, you can spot the Mohni Island and its lighthouse in the distance.

There are no shops or caterers between the start and finish points of this section.



This section can be divided into two days: Käsmu - Kasispea (18 km and an overnight stay) and Kasispea - Viinistu (8 km and an overnight stay), or take the bus in the section between Kasispea and Viinistu, just don't forget to check the bus timetables before.

FORESTS

The trail from Käsmu to Viinistu passes the largest field of boulders in Estonia and takes the hiker to the border between the sea and the pine forest. The route runs around, where the islands are a stopover for birds.

- 1 Käsmu field of boulders.**
Massive stones, the biggest standing 4.8 metres high. GPS: 59.608937, 25.908365

- 5 Viinistu village museum.**
