LOKSA - TSITRE, 21 km

Through the forests and swamps of the Juminda Peninsula

On this day, the Forest Trail crosses the Juminda Peninsula. After leaving Loksa, through an area of beautiful forests and marshes, with high, dense forested sand dunes at the western end of the territory. It continues down the road from Pedaspea to Tsitre and passes a small section of the North-Estonian Klint just before Tsitre, where the Muuksi stronghold hill is located. The Tsitre picnic area is located 0.2 km from the sea.

Be careful when walking on the side of the road!



There are no shops and catering services in the immediate vicinity of the trail, so pick up groceries in Loksa.



Buses run between Pedaspea and Tsitre (7 km). You can also plan your route along the Juminda Peninsula differently. On the first day, go from Loksa to the northernmost part of the Juminda Peninsula (about 20 km), where you will find the Juminda RMK campsite, the Juminda lighthouse and military heritage sites. You can stay the night in the RMK campsite or Leesi village (another 6 km). On the second day, continue from Juminda (22 km) or Leesi (15 km) to Tsitre.

FORESTS

The visitor hikes through the fragrant coniferous forest characteristic of Lahemaa national park, sometimes alternating with deciduous forest. Aabla bog is surrounded by sandy areas and dunes. The trail passes Lahemaa's largest rock, Majakivi, which lies beneath an old coniferous forest. There is an observation tower on the edge of the bog on the side of Aabla, from where one can see the Tallinn TV Tower, for example.
