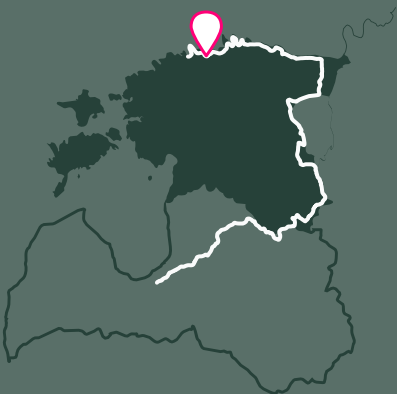




ESTONIA NORTH ESTONIAN COASTLINE



JÕELÄHTME - MUUGA, 16 km

Through Maardu, the phosphorite mining area

The Forest Trail passes the village of Jõelähtme, then turns northwest 1 km before the sea and follows the North-Estonian Klint for the next 3 kilometres. Behind Ülgase, the Forest Trail passes through Kallavere, Maardu and Muuga, the suburb of Tallinn. It takes a few hours to get from Muuga to Old Tallinn, but the Forest Trail takes a two-day detour through the Viimsi Peninsula before arriving at the capital of Estonia.

from Maardu and Muuga to
Tallinn with many bus stops
between the settlements.





FORESTS

Moving in the direction of Muuga the trail passes the Ülgase nature reserve, where rare, wet broadleaf cliff forests grow under the high bank. At the beginning of the road under the bank you can take a short 400-meter uphill walk to Hõbemägi (Silver Hill), where you can see the past two days track and enjoy an amazing view to the Finnish Gulf and nearby islands. The landscape is formed by historical and contemporary phosphorite mining sites.

WORTH SEENING!

- 1 Old phosphate mine of Ülgase.**
Closed in 1938, the caves created by mining phosphate rock are now a place for bats to hibernate.

Local coastal folk museum which tells a story of village's origin and its inhabitants.
