MUUGA - PÜÜNSI, 19 km

Through the magnificent Viimsi Peninsula

The Forest Trail passes through the most densely forested area of the Viimsi Peninsula, where several nature protection areas have been established. It crosses the former Soviet-era military territory in Rohuneeme. On this day, the Forest Trail follows along pedestrian sidewalks and the many roads running through the peninsula. It turns south at the Püünsi village, where towers, skyscrapers and the Port of Tallinn with ferries can be seen in the distance across the Gulf.

The trail leads through the former military territory by Rohuneeme.



A more direct road can be taken from the Muuga village to Tallinn (the walk will take from a couple of hours to about a half a day):

follow Muuga, Pärnamäe, Kloostrimetsa streets, pass the Tallinn TV Tower and Botanical Garden, then go further along the Pirita River health trails to Pirita beach, and continue via the waterfront promenade to downtown Tallinn. City buses pass through the Viimsi Peninsula (and to Muuga) and the network of stops is quite dense: www.visittallinn.ee/eng/visitor/plan/getting-around/public-transport. Feel free to take the taxi.

FORESTS

Muuga is an old Soviet-era area of summer residences. Muuga harbour, which is very important in the trade of oil products and other transit goods, is located by the bay. From Muuga, along the western part of the Viimsi Peninsula, the trail leads through the former coastal villages, which by now have become the suburbs of Tallinn. When the hiking trail is on a level ground, younger mixed forests grow along the path, sometimes beneath higher banks alternating with undercliff forests.
