



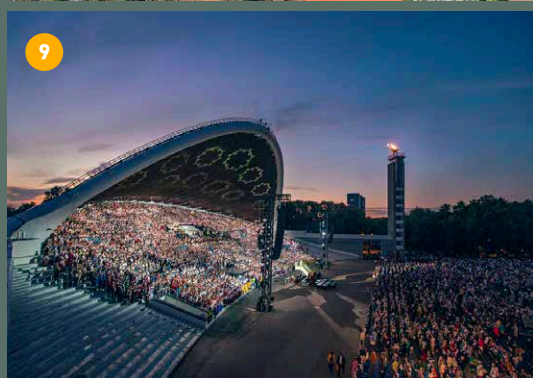

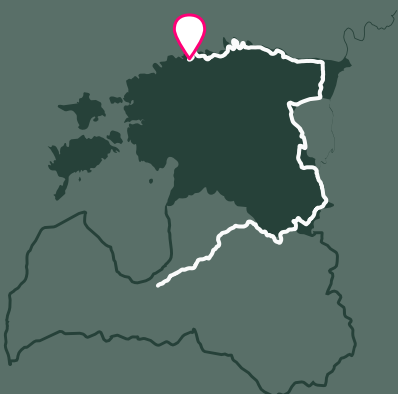

PÜÜNSI - TALLINN, 17 km

Most beautiful sights of Old Tallinn

The Forest Trail passes by the Gulf of Tallinn, and beautiful views of the towers, harbour and skyscrapers of the city can be seen as early as in Püünsi. The Forest Trail turns into a beautiful pine forest before Pirita, then follows along a sandy beach for 2 km. Behind Pirita, all the way to the Port of Tallinn, the Forest Trail takes you along the beautiful city waterfront promenade, which overlooks the city's most important cultural and historical sites, and offers beautiful views of the sea and the port. The final destination of the Forest Trail is located in the Port of Tallinn, next to the Old Town. You can spend another day or two visiting various tourist locations of Tallinn.

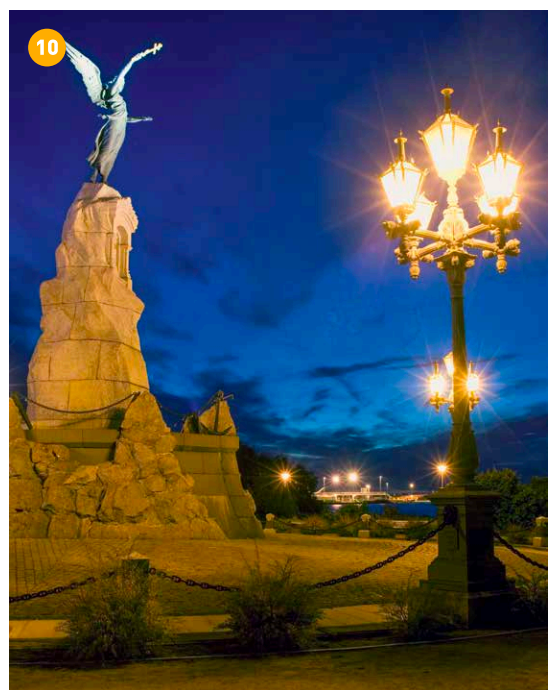

FORESTS

On the eastern shore of the Gulf of Tallinn, along the Viimsi peninsula, the hiking trail passes through old fishing villages of Püünsi, Pringi, Haabneeme, Miiduranna, etc. The old villages have now become a suburb of Tallinn. Looking north from the top of the peninsula can see Aegna island. To the west is Island Naissaar. There is a beautiful coastal pine forest on Pirita.

WORTH SEENING!

- 1 Viimsi open air museum.** Authentic and historical coastal village. GPS: 59.52333, 24.79777
- 2 Museum of coastal folk.** The museum focuses on the multifaceted history and culture of Estonian coastal folk. GPS: 59.52111, 24.80777
- 3 St. Jacob's Church in Viimsi.** This is the first and so far, the only Lutheran church built in Estonia since World War II. GPS: 59.52083, 24.80777
- 4 Tallinn recreation area and RMK Viimsi nature centre.** There is a permanent exhibition called "The Forest Has Might!". GPS: 59.51472, 24.81694
- 5 Pirita beach.** The biggest beach in Tallinn. GPS: 59.47058, 24.82953
- 6 Ruins of Bridgettine Convent.** In 1407 the largest nunnery in Old Livonia was founded here. GPS: 59.46751, 24.83601
- 7 Victims of communism memorial.** Dedicated to the Estonian people who suffered from Soviet terror. GPS: 59.45666, 24.81361
- 8 Estonian History Museum – Maarjamäe Palace.** Estonian Film Museum. The palace and the surrounding park were awarded the Best Tourism Object and Development Award in 2018. Film museum provides an overview of the history of Estonian films and the behind the scenes of the world's film industry. GPS: 59.45244, 24.81028
- 9 Tallinn song festival grounds.** Unique in Europe, a copy of the song stage was later erected in Vilnius. GPS: 59.44457, 24.80732
- 10 The Russalka memorial.** Memorial to those who lost their lives at the Gulf of Finland on the Russian navy vessel called Russalka. GPS: 59.44342, 24.79386
- 11 Kadriorg palace.** The palace with its magnificent main hall is one of the most beautiful examples of Baroque architecture in Estonia and in Northern Europe as a whole. GPS: 59.43856, 24.79096
- 12 Kadriorg park.** The most outstanding palatial and urban park in Estonia. GPS: 59.43870, 24.78582
- 13 Museum of Estonian architecture.** The museum has a permanent exhibition of the models of the city, providing an overview of Estonian architecture in the 20th century. GPS: 59.44028, 24.75652

- 14 The Naissaar Island.** In the 11th century records referred to as Terra Feminarum (Isle of Women). The island, mainly covered by forest, has been a nature park since 1995. There is a 11 km hiking trail. GPS: 59.558528, 24.550338
- 15 Promenade of the Reidi road.** A new 0.5 km promenade on the Reidi road is equipped with numerous benches and offers great views to the sea. GPS: 59.44328, 24.78560
